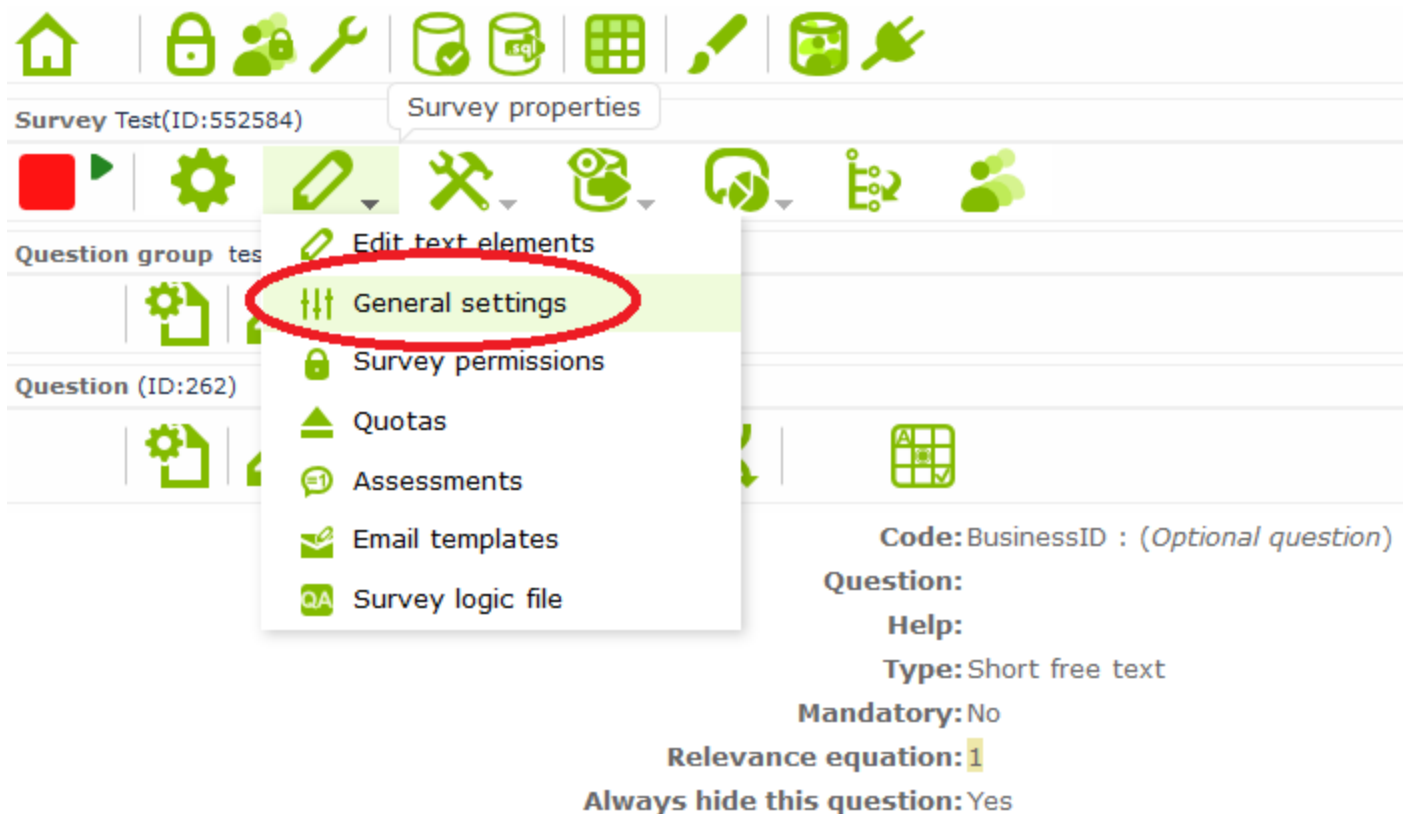

Click on “Show advance settings” and then choose “Yes” for “Always hide this question”.

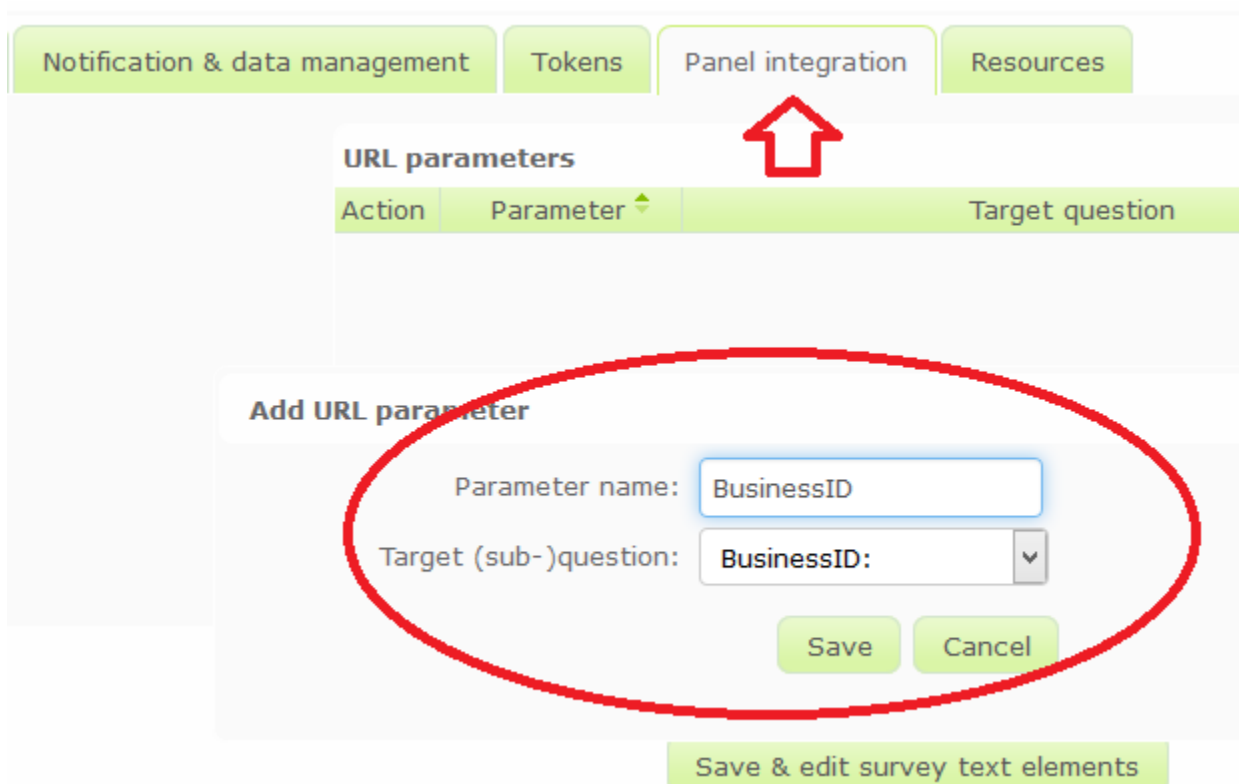
Choose “Short free text box”.
