A genuine interest in literature can be awakened only by reading the original. Brief contents reflect only the surface layer, on the basis of which deep work with the text is impossible. In order to create a good work, you should independently see in a story, poem or novel an unusual plot, deep meaning, relevance and talented word. It is very useful to read good works created by other authors. Samples of them can now be found in many sources. Examples of where they can be found are special manuals, collections, magazines. After reading a few of these samples, you will appreciate the features of the style, the language of the author, the structure. And, finally, the last rule: never sit down for a clean sheet. You must have a plan in your head, an image of the future text.

## Plan

Always try to have some plan. What is it? The plan of writing on literature invariably includes the following three parts: this is the introduction, the main part and the conclusion.

## Entry

The main goal of the introduction is to anticipate what will be discussed in the main part. The beginning of a paper is a place where you can Express your feelings and thoughts. Entry "advertises" the rest of the text, engages the readers. Here it will be appropriate to use interesting statements, epigraphs, as well as to indicate the General mood of your work. It is necessary to formulate in it the key problem questions - those that can be answered within the framework of the proposed topic, and then, choosing one or two of them that you will disclose in your paper. We also recommend to give the terms that you will use in the answer, to define them, which will show their understanding by the author. No need to be afraid of question marks. Formulate boldly interrogative sentences. The beginning of the work (the introductory part) sometimes briefly characterizes either the work itself or the era of its creation, if the topic proposed to the author involves the analysis of a separate aspect.

**Main part**

The main part is the disclosure of the theme. If this is the image of the hero, it should be considered holistically, while not leaving important details "overboard" - because they are for something still noted by the Creator of the work. You should not write, if the paper topic you have not understood, if somewhere lost the plot. It may be necessary in this case to re-read the work. Do not be afraid to ask questions to the teacher - he will only approve of your curiosity and interest. The main part should be an evidence-based. In it you have to convince the reader that you have set them correctly and solve them correctly. This is the largest part by volume. It should be paid special attention when thinking about how to write a paper. A model of thought presented by a critic can be developed if you like his idea very much: to present your own observations, to explain it in your own words.
